One simple rule of thumb: Treat the photoshoot as if it were a showing...for everyone. The internet is the new curb appeal - The photos and video will be online for all potential buyers to see. Here are a few simple tips to make your home look its best, and to make the shoot go smoothly.



Exterior:

- Move vehicles into the garage or down the street. Garage doors should be closed.
- Make sure fence gates are unlocked and pets are safely restrained.
- Close all windows and doors.
- If you have blinds, open them slightly, slanting upward. This will help with both exterior and interior shots.



Interior:

- The more light the better. Any available overhead light and lamp should be turned on.
- Turn ceiling fans off. Rotating fans will cause a blur in the photos.
- Blinds should be slightly open, slanting upward. This will keep any glare off of the floors.
- Find a "safe zone" for extra clutter. A hall closet, laundry room, or extra bedroom can be a good place to temporarily store toys, pets, or anything you do not wish to have photographed.

Photo shoots usually take anywhere from 45 minutes to 2 hours depending on square footage and services.
